

# Measures for certification in Ukraine 2015:

## Results meeting CBs and Com/CAs

- Companies that were previously certified by the CBs that were delisted by the Commission must have signed a contract with a new CB before July 8, 2015 in order to be certified for the 2015 season.
- CBs are normally expected to inspect the applicant during critical production phases. In UA, 2015 only, the fields must have been inspected at least once during the growing season, before harvest.
- There must also be an inspection of the facilities after harvest.
- CBs are to analyse samples of the product in stock before issuing a Transaction Certificate (extra requirement of Com for UA 2015).
- All old stocks are classified as suspicious. Their presence must have been part of the application with the new CB and confirmed by the stock list provided by delisted CB.
- Old stocks shall be subject to a physical inspection of the operator before release of a TC.
- Delisted CBs to provide a complete client' dossier, including earlier non-conformities. New CB is to close out the open non-conformities.
- The Commission asked all CBs active in Ukraine to provide a report on their activities by September 1 to be able to monitor imports.
