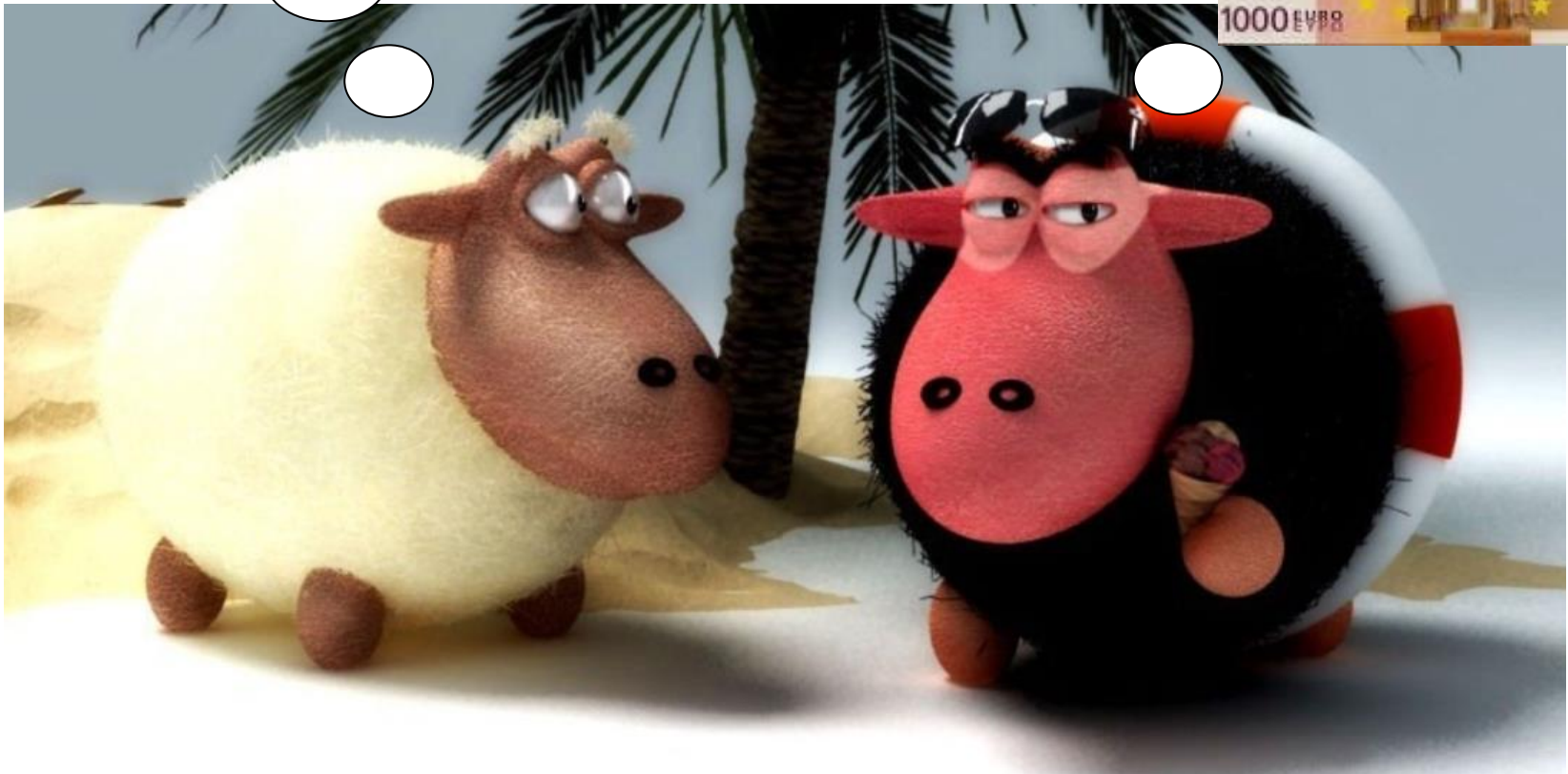

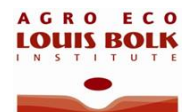

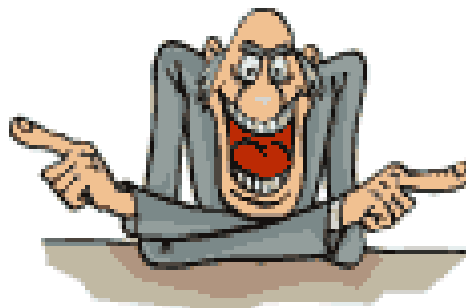


Production Rules

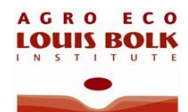

Paper-driven and not integrity-orientated

- › Checklist governance

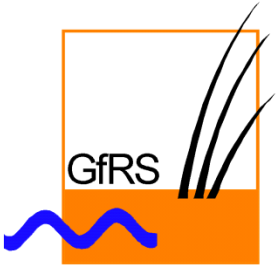
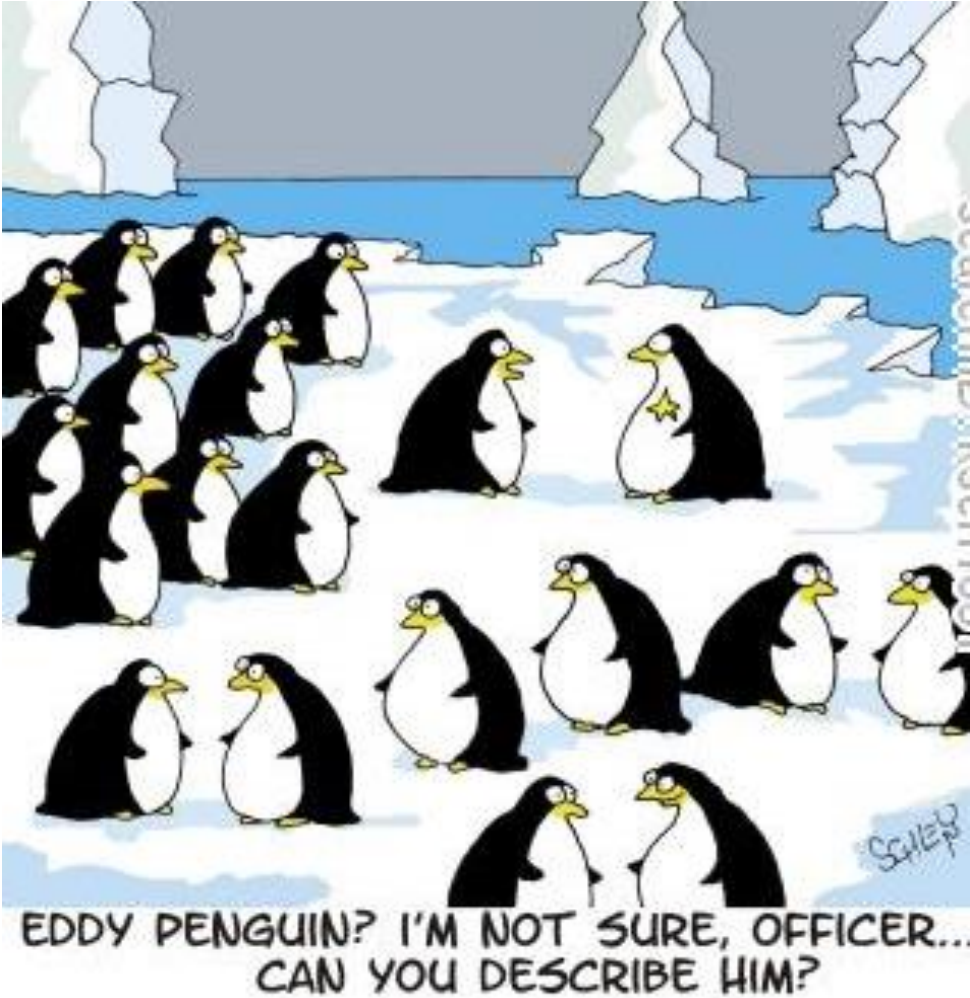


- › Complicated and bureaucratic procedures



- › Authorities, accreditation bodies and control bodies lack own accountability

The future challenge: Better identification of fraudsters



Perspective: Inspection and certification

- › Competent authorities/Accreditation bodies:
 - Simple administrative procedures (e.g. notifications)
 - Risk-orientated and co-ordinated surveillance
- › Operators:
 - Implementation of a system of Organic Critical Points (OCP)
- › Authorities and control bodies:
 - Introduction of a risk-orientated inspection system (frequency and type of inspection)
- › Control bodies: Capacity building for organic inspectors
- › Organic sector: Internet platforms (certificates, traceability)
